Our Endoscopy units at CHEC Sheffield offer:

- Two endoscopy procedure rooms.
- Single sex admission rooms.
- Single sex changing and waiting area.
- An en-suite enema room.
- Single sex recovery area for patients immediately post-procedure.
- Private consultation room to maintain privacy and dignity, whilst discharging and discussing findings and all relevant aftercare.
- A decontamination area, which is purpose built, is situated behind the procedure rooms, and complies with HTMO1-06 guidance.

Providing:

- Consultant Triage.
- Gastroenterology Outpatient Assessment.
- Gastroscopy.

- Colonoscopy.
- Flexi- Sigmoidoscopy.
- Upper and Lower Gastrointestinal (GI).
- Therapeutic Treatments including Simple Biopsies, Polyp Removal (1cm max), Haemorrhoid Removal.

Inclusion Criteria:

- Over the age of 18.
- ASA Grades 1 & 2.
- ✓ Weight <220kg.

- Able to consent.

Exclusion Criteria:

- Under 18 year olds.
- X ASA Grades 3 & 4.
- Weight >220kg.
- Myocardial infarction or stroke within the last 6 weeks.
- (x) Patients who lack capacity.
- Currently pregnant.
- Total dysphagia.
- (x) Fitted with a cardiac implantable device.
- (X) High risk of Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease.
- Extremely vulnerable or shielding patients.
