Our working days at IGS operate rather differently to traditional GP surgeries, please ask us for more information. Our innovative working pattern is able to provide a varied working pattern allowing patient contacts to be kept to an average of 6-9 face to face consultations either followed by a break or a change in activity. On-call days can get busy but you are not on your own, our duty doctor is supported during the busy morning period by a second GP, who also completes the morning visits. There is also protected admin/paperwork time in the day.
