Due to upcoming maternity leave, an exciting opportunity has arisen to join a new enthusiastic and friendly team at Oakhill Medical Practice.

Oakhill Medical Practice is a purpose-built, owner-occupied practice, located in a quiet residential area in Dronfield - so an easy commute of Sheffield and Chesterfield. We are a small, dedicated team. We are part of the Chesterfield and Dronfield Primary Care Network, working closely with the teams, ie pharmacy, social prescribing.

We are a 4000-patient practice, using SystmOne and Ardens. We are a teaching practice with a current cohort of Early Year Students and 3a placements. We have our own car park and designated doctor spaces.

We are currently a 2-partner practice, assisted by 3 salaried GPs and a strong professional team, also supported by an experienced admin and reception team.

We have a high focus on staff wellbeing with appointments being set up with the BMA recommendation of 25 or less appointments per day in mind. We work as a team to support each other with urgent extras being shared. Additional capacity is triaged so there is no uncapped duty.

We strongly believe in continuity being the best way to work for both patients and staff, so we only cross cover admin for holidays, and we follow up our own results. We currently have minimal input from ARRS roles so GPs deal with a mixture of complexity and minor illness.

We will design an appointment rota which suits the candidate, this could be a mixture of face-to-face appointments and telephone consultations.

We will consider 3-5 sessions a week, starting in February 2024, we expect to need cover for 9 months, £9,500 per session per annum (pro rata) plus indemnity paid.

When working in the triage team you will have limited F2F/telephone contact with patients and usually won't be expected to deal with paperwork. To ensure variety, candidates also have the opportunity to work as a clinician in one of our practices as well.

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PAs will be asked to attend a preceptorship programme for 1 session if working on a Thursdays.
